WHAT THEY DID

- Restructure nursing research course to include mini-bootcamps
- Feed research coursework into the senior practicum requirements
- Add additional writing resources

RESULTS

- Momentum is more manageable
- Progressively build on foundational competencies
- Assess student throughout the developmental process

Students Need Time to Remediate and Learn

WHAT THEY DID

- Weekly meetings and multiple touchpoints with students
- Prompt written and video feedback from faculty
- One-on-one tutoring

RESULTS

- A systematic, step-by-step approach
- Catch students who are struggling early
- Provide timely, immediate, actionable feedback
