Review of relevant literature and research related to the changes in standards



Interviews from dozens of experts in the nursing profession



Feedback from current and former nursing customers



All the research culminated in a year-long, multi-survey national pilot...

Sets of new learning questions tested, one each for BSN, MSN, and DNP degree levels

Number of nursing programs across the United States chose to participate in the survey pilot

Number of graduating nursing students completed exit surveys that included the new questions

The updated surveys provide practical questions and actionable data.



Each survey has a new, validated set of learning questions that are unique to each degree level.



Learning questions parallel across exit and alumni within each degree level.



All exit and alumni surveys have the same eight learning factors, making it easier to compare within your entire program.



All new learning questions align closely with the domains and competencies in AACN's updated Essentials.

Feedback from nursing programs played the biggest role in shaping the process.



You said you needed shorter surveys that were easier for students and alumni to complete.

You said you needed a balance between improvements and maintaining longitudinal data.

You said you needed easier ways to get employment data for CCNE accreditation.



The updated exit and alumni surveys are 20% shorter than before without sacrificing depth.

We made no changes to the satisfaction questions or factors on any of the surveys.

We updated our employment questions to better align with CCNE's reporting definition.
